### **Standard Operating Procedure: Emergency Vehicle Operator Training Program**

#### SUBJECT

Emergency vehicle operator for the Wales Center Volunteer Fire Co., Inc.

#### PURPOSE

To re-qualify every other year to maintain Emergency vehicle operator status for Engine 2, Engine 3, Rescue 7 or Ambulance 8.

#### PROCEDURE

In order to maintain an Emergency Vehicle Operator status for Engine 2, Engine 3, Rescue 7 or Ambulance 8, a member of the company must re qualify every other year.

#### APPROVAL TO RE QUALIFY

- Posses a valid NYS Drivers license
- Must be at least 21 years of age
- Non probationary active member in good standing with no disciplinary reports filed
- Must pass driving requirements and applicable tests for each vehicle
- The Captain of each vehicle along with Appointed driver training team will approve and submit the paperwork to the Fire Chief for his/her final approval

#### DRIVING REQUIREMENTS RESCUE 7

- Must know where all equipment is located and know how to operate
- Must Pass traffic cone maze (*see attached*)
- Must pass driving test (*see attached*)

#### DRIVING REQUIREMENTS ENGINE 3

- Must pass pump test
- Must know where all equipment is located and know how to operate
- Must Pass traffic cone maze (*see attached*)
- Must pass driving test (*see attached*)

#### DRIVING REQUIREMENTS ENGINE 2

- Must pass pump test
- Must know where all equipment is located and know how to operate
- Must Pass traffic cone maze (*see attached*)

- Must pass driving test (*see attached*)

DRIVING REQUIREMENTS AMBULANCE 8

- Must Pass traffic cone maze (*see attached*)
- Must pass driving test (*see attached*)

*Issue Date: January 5, 2009*

1. The member gets in the driver seat of the apparatus and acquaints him or herself with the controls
2. The member should put on seat belt.
3. The member should leave the Fire Hall and head west on route 20A.
4. The member should turn left on route 78.
5. The member should go to Hunters Creek Rd. and turn right.
6. The member should go to Warner Hill Rd and turn left.
7. The member should go to 12558 Warner Hill Rd., and with the trainers assistance he or she should back in the approach of the driveway.
8. The member then goes east on Warner Hill
9. The member is then to turn left on Merlau rd.
10. The member is to go to Route 78 and turn left.
11. When the member gets to Hunters Creek Rd he or she is to turn right.
12. When the member gets to Big Tree Rd he or she is turns right and proceed to East Blood Rd.
13. When the member gets to East Blood rd he or she is to turn left on East blood Rd.
14. When the member gets to old Big Tree Rd. They should turn left and proceed to the end of the road.
15. Upon reaching the end of Old Big Tree Rd the trainer should assist the member in backing up toward East Blood Rd.
16. After backing up East blood Rd. the member should return to the Fire Hall and back the apparatus into its bay.
